Detail

- **T1 — public.** Renders on `read.vade-app.dev`. Foundations default here once ratified; some retrospectives and per-memo Tier-1 candidates also route here. License: CC-BY-4.0.
- **T2a — operational.** Lives in the repo, doesn’t publish. The default for memos, internal retrospectives, lineage manifests.
- **T2b — identity, BDFL-gated.** Identity-layer additions and `CB-*/OG-*` changes require BDFL ratification before they can promote out of T2a. Empty by default; entries land via separate PRs each gated on Ven.
- **Q1 — quarantined.** The v3 letter to Anthropic. Routes to a publication path only when several enactment gates are live (F2 audit, F4 audit, F1 commission in train, F7 initial pass on record, BDFL route ratification).

The model is fail-closed by design: without an explicit allowlist entry, a file lands in main but does not publish. Disposition- proposal §3.3 names the closure.
